In terms of activities, in the June members night, we had Tom Jarman return to provide the group with a fantastic presentation on lakes fishing. Tom gave the group a great insight into this significant part of fly fishing, which for many of us can be quite challenging. He went into great detail of what to look for when approaching a lake, the location, the presentation, the retrieve and the setup of your leaders and flies.

Then in the July members night we had Tim Curni from Native Fishes Australia, and a freshwater ecologist, give a talk on fly fishing regarding some of our native fishes such as Trout Cod, Murray Cod, Macquarie Perch and others. It was also refreshing to hear from Tim that much of the work being done by native fish groups and trout fishing groups are working together to ensure a great fishery can be sustained for everyone. He outlined that much of this work will need to be done by volunteers and some of the work previously done by groups, such as ourselves, will help sustainable habitats for both trout and native fishes. There are a few events coming up that we will ensure members are kept abreast of, so you can participate in the future of our fisheries.

We have a great many more presenters at the next few members nights, so make sure you come along on the 2nd Wednesdays of the month.

Casting competitions also continue over the next few months with several events at SFF. We will be looking for volunteers for various roles but it would be great to come along and cheer on the SFF competitors as well. I've just come back from Weipa in Cape York and if you ever want to fish barramundi, you need to be fairly accurate at casting. You could argue that the rings in a casting competition need to be half the size for barra. And of course, the wily trout often will be sitting under that ledge, or under a branch, so accuracy - and a few tips and tricks – is paramount, and easily finessed if you practice and even consider competing.

Member's Bargain Table


At each General Meeting Night (4th Wednesday), there will be a table set up for Members to offer items for sale/auction.
